

Odyssey is considered a “full service” ride and provides the following

1. World (year-long) riders receive all scheduled transportation once the trip leaves LA. Stage riders receive transportation between connecting stages.
2. All scheduled transportation during a stage.
3. Dinners and breakfasts each day of the tour. Limited vegetarian diets accommodated.
4. Overnight facilities. At least half the year will be spent in hotels (usually 2 or three to a room), hostels or bunk beds at private facilities. Slightly less than 50% of the evenings will be spent camping in government and private campgrounds, on school grounds and at other municipal and private facilities.
5. TK&A's own shower tents (great hot water) to augment those at existing facilities when the need exists.
6. DRGs (Daily Route Guides)—a written set of instructions describing how to navigate from one overnight location to the next. DRGs also include a map of the route.
7. Daily transportation for your gear, often in TK&A's specially designed trailers with 17"X17"X34" private lockable lockers. Otherwise, we use large box trucks.
8. Several well equipped (water, pumps, spare parts, first-aid kits, basic tools, etc.) support vehicles staffed with Odyssey pros ready to provide assistance during each cycling day.
9. An Odyssey bike for world cyclists. Stage riders receive a credit towards the purchase of a new "official Odyssey bike" for each stage they are registered.
10. Professional, well stocked, traveling bike shop with expert, friendly help.
11. Emergency first-aid support, information about inoculations and tips on remaining healthy when traveling, particularly in developing nations.
12. Emergency phone numbers to access Odyssey road management.
13. Emergency telephone numbers for your family in the event of an emergency.
14. Mail stops about every three weeks.
15. Local information on doing laundry, buying snacks, sight seeing, etc.
16. Local entertainment.
17. Private phone coaching from an Odyssey 2000® veteran on how to prepare for and what to expect for your tour.
18. A Rider Handbook and several Rider Memos with tips on training, world travel techniques, trip preparation, clothing, equipment, camping, health, etc.
19. Substantially reduced fees for TK&A's Wheeling Hawaii and/or Wheeling Washington weeklong cycling tours to get a feel for how Odyssey is run.
20. A well-trained, understanding and supportive staff willing to work hard to make your ride as successful as possible.
21. Leadership by North America's most experienced team of long-distance bicycling event creators and managers.

Route

Odyssey World Cycling Tours™ will travel to the following countries: USA, New Zealand, Australia, Hong Kong, China, Vietnam, Thailand, Malaysia, Singapore, Czech Republic, Germany, Austria, Liechtenstein, Switzerland, Luxembourg, Belgium, France, England, Wales, Ireland, Northern Ireland, Scotland, Norway, Sweden, Denmark, Finland, Russia, Greece, Italy, Vatican City, San Marino, Monaco, Andorra, Spain, Gibraltar, Morocco, Portugal, South Africa, Swaziland, Argentina and Chile. If it can be arranged and weather permitting, we will also arrange for an additional cost flight to Antarctica.

TK&A reserves the right to alter the final itinerary at its discretion. Some of the reasons might include the availability of transportation, fuel, food, potable water or the political climate of a respective country of the world.



Odyssey World Cycling Tours™ fees until June 30, 2001

Interested in riding the entire Odyssey? Take advantage of our initial pricing for Odyssey in 2003. We are extending the rate of \$49,000, less early registration and payment discounts, until June 30, 2001. These discounts can reduce the entire price for a year on the road to a low of \$37,485 (\$103 a day). The required registration fee for the entire Odyssey is a nonrefundable \$1000.

Fees after July 1, 2001

After July 1, the cost for the entire Odyssey World Cycling Tours™ is from \$46,227 (\$127 day) to \$73,000 (\$200 day), depending on how early you register and whether you take advantage of our special payment discounts.

Stage rider fees

You can select one or more stages of your choosing. The price per day on each stage ranges from a low of \$127 a day to a high of \$200 a day, depending on how early you register and whether or not you take advantage of our special payment discounts. Now, for a little more than the cost of riding across America, you can spend 41 days in incredible South Africa. Or if you prefer, spend 25 spectacular days riding the European Alps from Prague to Geneva for as little as \$3195. The required registration fee for Odyssey stages is a nonrefundable \$500 per stage.

Payment options

Whether cycling the world or a stage, you can usually choose to make monthly payments, 2 equal payments, 3 equal payments (world riders only) or prepay the entire amount for the maximum discount available. All fees and payments are in US\$. Fees can be paid by cash, check, wire transfer, Visa, MasterCard or American Express.

Transportation surcharge

In the unlikely event that transportation charges increase beyond reasonable inflation levels, TK&A has a right to add a surcharge to the effected ride stage.

Refund Policy

The \$500 stage and \$1000 World Tour deposits are non-refundable. 85% of all additional fee payments are refundable until September 30, 2002. From October to November 30, 2002, 50% of all additional fee payments are refundable. There are no refunds given for any reason after December 1, 2002. All refund requests must be in writing. Refunds will not be given to anyone asked to leave the trip because he or she is, in the opinion of TK&A, compromising the safety or success of Odyssey.
