

General considerations in South Africa

- Ride on the **left** side of the road.
- You can drink the water.
- The exchange rate is about 6 Rand to the US\$.
- Expect it to get light around 6 am and dark at 8:30 pm. This changes as we go south and west towards Cape Town.
- South Africa does not have daylight savings time and is on one time zone.
- Expect sun, heat (maybe even greater than 100° F) and dry weather until you hit the coast, then we will add some humidity. Use plenty of sunscreen, carry lots of water and fill up often.
- South Africa can have pretty demanding terrain, even if it has some of the most beautiful country in the world. It promises to be hot, remote and mostly rural without many full service areas. So, leave early, carry plenty of water, always carry food and snacks, and pace yourself in such a way as to enjoy every kilometer.
- Many of South Africa's roads don't have shoulders and can be quite busy, so ride alertly. Some are in need of repair, though most are good roads.
- South Africans move onto the shoulder to allow others to pass. Great custom, but can be a little hair raising for cyclists. We don't expect problems, of course, but just be aware.
- South Africa feels like most "first world" nations, though you will see a lot of poverty. Change is slow and agonizing.
- As you will find, most all South Africans are extremely friendly and welcoming people. You will get lots of smiles and waves.
- There are many stores along the way and many have lots of people hanging around them, especially in small towns. Even though this can be a little intimidating, don't worry about it. Feel free to get what you need. The people are normally very friendly.
- Security is a big issue in South Africa. You will see lots of guards-some armed, and fences and barbed wire around homes, businesses and compounds-it looks pretty intimidating at times. It's very unlikely any of us will have any problems, especially if you follow some basic precautions: ride with at least 1 or 2 others at all times; don't leave bikes unattended unless they are locked securely, then not for long; take your "easily removed" items when you go into a store or leave your bike; keep an eye on your stuff; and use common sense.
- Phones are rare except in the bigger communities. Use 'em when you see 'em.
- In South Africa a robot is a traffic light. Seriously.
