- The currency is the United Kingdom Pounds (GBP), valued at .63 to \$1. 1£ is equal to \$1.60.
- English is the primary language but you can speak Spanglish.
- Gibraltar is a super little country of 25,000 Gibs or so, tied to the United Kingdom. However, Spain wants it back and they have had lots of conflicts over the years.
- The airport runway is also the highway. When a plane needs to land or take-off, they simply close the runway to traffic. In a few minutes, it's open again.
- A good deal of the country is a nature preserve and is worth exploring. A ride around the island is also a cool thing to do.
- Expect daylight from 7:20 am to 9:10 pm each day. The weather should be sunny and warm to hot, at least it should be. As Odyssey's luck goes, it's still a good idea to have warm clothes.
- The people are friendly. And there are plenty of British goods to buy.

General Consideration for Southern Spain

- The currency of Spain is the pesetas, valued at approximately 169 to \$1.
- The weather should be a lot warmer than we have experienced in the north, perhaps into the 90 and 100's. Don't put away your cold weather gear just yet.
- Expect daylight from 7:00 am to 9:15 pm each day.
- Keep your Spanish speaking abilities high.
- Still some climbing and rolling hills through semi-arid terrain. Lots of olives again. Beautiful countryside.

• General Consideration for Portugal

- The Portugal currency is the Escudo and is about 203 to \$1. Roughly, divide the cost by 200 to arrive at US equivalent.
- Some English spoken here.
- Time change. Expect daylight from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm. The weather???. Should be great, right?
- Expect a a little more active police checkpoints, etc. Be sure to keep your passport handy.
- Remote, but beautiful country for much of our route.
- Super people. Many gypsies in Portugal. Portuguese is their language, not Spanish, just like Brazil.
